Luca Gardini - 96 Points

Tony Wood Italian Wine - 95 Points

Bright ruby red in colour with purple undertones. Amazing aroma of spring flowers, violet, petal, sweet red fruits, liquorice, cedar, dry forest floor, spice. Creamy, elegant, fantastic length and balance. A total winner!

Jancis Robinson - 16 Points

Radda in Chianti. 90% Sangiovese, 10% Merlot. Aged for 12 months in large 30-hl oak casks. Certified organic.

Just mid ruby. A shy, brooding cherry nose that is a little stalky, but improves with aeration. Fragrant, tangy cherry fruit that is just medium bodied. Ends a little racy, and with just enough concentration to balance this, before it becomes tart. Creamy note on the finish, which reminds me of new oak, which this apparently didn't get. (WS)

Tom Hyland - 91 Points

90% Sangiovese, 10% Merlot. Bright young garnet; aromas of morel cherry, strawberry preserves and red poppy. Medium-full with very good concentration. Very good acidity and persistence, notable complexity and rich, well-balanced tannins. This is still quite young and is tightly wrapped; wait one or two years, with peak in 5-8 years, although it may drink well for another year or two.

Wines Critics - 91 Points

Sangiovese verace nelle note radiose e pulitissime di ciliegie, fiori di limone, buccia di arancio, cedro e cannella. Corpo medio, tannini maturi, estrazione davvero soffice dei componenti polifenolici nella matrice ed un finale di incredibile bevibilità. Bevi ora.

Decanter - 90 Points

Wine Specttaor - 90 Points

Juicy cherry, strawberry and currant fruit abounds, along with a savoury side sporting thyme, juniper and earth notes. It finishes with dusty tannins. Drink now through 2025. — BS
