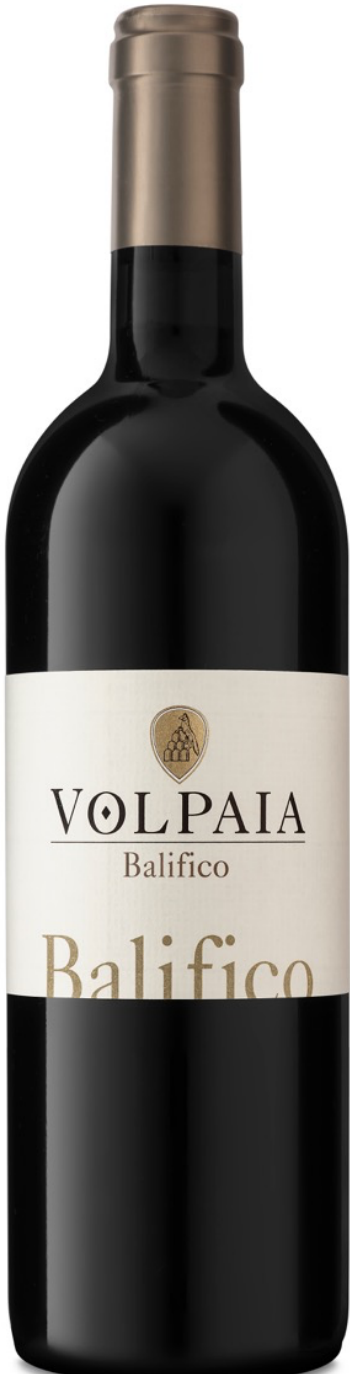




CASTELLO DI VOLPAIA

Luca Maroni - 95 points

Wine Spectator - 94 points

A juicy, black cherry-laced red, displaying fine concentration, balance and freshness. Dusty tannins gather on the finish, as do accents of oak spice. Shows fine harmony and complexity overall, though will benefit from a year or two of bottle age. Sangiovese and Cabernet Sauvignon. Best from 2023 through 2038. — BS

James Suckling - 94 points

Pretty, ripe fruit with berries, citrus fruit and hints of almonds that follow through to a medium body, fine tannins and a clean and fresh finish. Drink now or hold.

Anteprima nel 2018

James Suckling - 93-94 points

Dusty texture to this young red with a plum and dark-berry character. Firm tannins and a focused finish. Solid. A blend of 65% sangiovese and 35% cabernet sauvignon. Made from organically grown grapes.

Falstaff - 92 points

Glänzendes, sattes Rubinviolett. Intensive Nase mit Noten nach Gojibeere, Cassis und Heidelbeere. Griffiges Tannin am Gaumen, strömt ruhig dahin, wirkt insgesamt aber etwas spröde.
